


EEG Accessibility Fund



In 2019 Eastern Edge Gallery will be extending its accessibility initiatives through a designated fund. This is an annual limited fund of \$2,000 to be split into stipends of \$200 for up to 10 recipients, which can be applied to by Eastern Edge members in good standing and exhibiting artists.

This funding will provide financial aid to members from beyond the Avalon Peninsula to travel to St. John's for various art opportunities (non-exclusive to events associated with Eastern Edge). Funding can also be applied for by visiting artists to assist with extraneous financial accommodations such as child-care or other personal needs.

To apply for the accessibility fund please send a short letter of request to gallery@easternedge.ca outlining the activity for which you are seeking financial assistance. Please title your email 'Application to the accessibility fund.' Applications can be made at any time while funds last. Please anticipate a response within two weeks of submission.

Please note all successful applicants will be required to submit one paragraph to EE outlining how the fund supported them and their art activity.

Activities include but are not limited to: Travel to the Avalon to undertake art activities including gallery visits, attending talks/ plays/ performances/ festivals, meetings. Child care to enable attendance of art activities or production of art.
