

Main Gallery Programming Committee - Terms of Reference



Eastern Edge's Main Gallery programming seeks to facilitate critical dialogue concerning issues in contemporary art and society, actively encouraging emerging and established artists whose work speaks to feminist, multicultural, queer, and other diverse perspectives. Our call for Main Gallery submissions is open to local, provincial, national, and international artists.

Main Gallery Programming Committee members will most often communicate with Eastern Edge's Programming Coordinator. The current Programming Coordinator is Laura Sbrizzi. The Chair of the Committee must be a member of the Board of Directors. The current chair of the committee is Shan Pomeroy.

As a member of the Main Gallery Programming Committee, your responsibilities include:

- Helping to develop new programming initiatives, when needed
- [Evaluating current programming policies](#) and recommending future changes, when needed
- Reviewing the process and documents for the '[Call for Main Gallery Submissions](#)'
- Helping to share and distribute the Main Gallery Call for Submissions
- Evaluating artists' submissions and selecting exhibiting artists once or twice a year
- Be available to meet 1-4 times a year. Meeting quorum will be two-thirds of the members present.
- Committee terms are 2-year terms, with the option to serve 3 terms total (a maximum of 6 years on the committee)

The Committee Terms of Reference will be reviewed annually by EE's Board of Directors. Last review: January 9, 2026.
