

rOGUE Gallery Programming Committee - Terms of Reference

The rOGUE Gallery is a 4 x 7 metre space within Eastern Edge dedicated to showcasing work by Eastern Edge members, with a special focus on local practices and works by artists with a connection to Newfoundland and Labrador, emerging artists, and experimental art practices.



rOGUE Gallery Programming Committee members will most often communicate with Eastern Edge's Programming Coordinator. The current Programming Coordinator is Laura Sbrizzi. The Chair of the Committee must be a member of the Board of Directors. The current chair of the committee is Anhelina Shevchenko.

As a member of the rOGUE Committee, your responsibilities include:

- Helping to develop new programming initiatives, when needed
- [Evaluating current programming policies](#) and recommending future changes, when needed
- Reviewing the process and documents for the '[rOGUE Gallery Call for Submissions](#)'
- Helping to share and distribute the rOGUE Call for Submissions
- Evaluating artists' submissions and selecting exhibiting artists once or twice a year
- Be available to meet 1-4 times a year. Meeting quorum will be two-thirds of the members present.
- Committee terms are 2-year terms, with the option to serve 3 terms total (a maximum of 6 years on the committee)

The rOGUE is an entry-level exhibition space and this is an entry-level committee. It often serves as an introduction to Eastern Edge, how committees work and how programming is selected. It is a great opportunity for emerging artists to learn how proposals are evaluated and selected.

The Committee Terms of Reference will be reviewed annually by EE's Board of Directors. Last review: January 9, 2026.
